As we document the achievements and milestones of the past year, we remain committed to advancing our quality benchmarks and setting new standards for the years to come.


Composition of IQAC for 2023-24


Inauguration Electoral Literacy Club on 19/07/2023


Academic and Administrative Audit (19.10.2023 – 30.10.2023)
