HOME VEGETABLE GARDEN

Consuming more fresh fruits and vegetables is one of the most important things one can do to stay healthy. When we pick vegetables right from our garden, the vitamin content will be at its highest. Also, we are reducing the risk of eating vegetables that contain harmful chemicals. To impart this message to the society, the NSS volunteers set up vegetable gardens in their home by the guidelines of the environment enrichment programme and shared the vegetables to the poor and needy villagers, who were jobless during the second phase of Lockdown.



BIOFERTILIZER CUM BIOPESTICIDE GIVING OUT

Biofertlizers are a technological innovation that has the potential to increase crop yield, reduce production cost and improve soil conditions. Biofertilizers are inexpensive to farmers because of low cost and their ability to help improve soil structure, texture and water holding capacity. PG department of Microbiology developed a biofertilizer cum biopesticide product namely "Pencifert" in the laboratory using *Penicillium citrinum* fungus. They could distribute a quantity of 50 packets of product, 500 gm each to the farmers in the adopted village of Edayoor panchayath. The trained students practiced the farmers on the right usage and application of fertilizer to the soil.

BIO SEED – A BIOLOGICAL SEED TREATEMENT AND ITS FIELD TRIALS

Seed inoculation has been considered as a precise and cost-effective method to deliver microbial inoculants with the potential for large -scale production. Seed coating has been proposed as a promising tool for inoculation of different crop seeds. Microbial application improve both productivity and heath of crops. Seed treatment protects the germinating seedlings form seed-born pathogens. With the aim of this PG Department of Microbiology develop Bio Seed – seed coated with biocontrol agent *Pseudomonas* and invitro field trials were conducted in the adopted village

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT - INSTALLATION OF PIPE COMPOST

Composting is an important part of waste management since food and other compostable material make about 20% of waste in landfill and these materials take longer to biodegrade in the landfill. Pipe composting is a type of Vermi composting often called wormtube composting carried out within a PVC tube. It reduces the use of chemical fertilizer and retains soil moisture and suppresses plant disease and pests. PG department of microbiology initiated undertaking towards successful waste management by installing the pipe compost sponsored by MASC in the college and various houses situated in the Edayoor Panchayath on.Vice president of the Edayoor Panchayath Mr.Moideenkutty inaugurated the programme. Principal Dr.P.Mohamedali installed the pipe compost at college and Member of the Edayoor Panchayath Mr.Ameer installed the venture at houses of Mr.Kunjippa.


INNOVATING VALUE ADDED COCONUT PRODUCT

COMPARISON THE QUALITY OF WATER FROM BORE WELLS AND OPEN WELLS

Elements such as copper, iron, calcium, magnesium, and many more contribute to various biological processes such as oxygen transport, enzymatic catalysis, DNA synthesis, and cell maturation. The most abundant source of these elements is water. With the Aim of this the students of the chemistry department collected water samples from Bore wells and Open wells from the adopted village in Edayur panchayath and compared the presence of certain ions in them. Certain ions such as Calcium and Iron were found to be higher in Bore wells than in open wells. Some suggestions on the better usage of bore well water were provided to the users in consultation with Mr. Sajesh, Quality controller of Kerala water authority.



WATER QUALITY TESTING

Department of Chemistry, Majlis Arts and Science College, Puramannur analysed the B.O.D and D.O content of different water samples collected from five places in Bharathapuzha namely Pulamanthole, Thrithala, Kuttipuram, Thirunavaya and Thiruvegappura. From the analysis, it is evident that the most polluted area is Thiruvegappura. Also high value of B.O.D at Thiruvegappura indicates that the area is more contaminated. The least polluted area is at Thirunavaya which is evident from its high D.O and low B.O.D value. It is found that all the water samples are highly polluted as per the D.O and B.O.D values








LED BULB WORKSHOP

MUSHROOM CULTIVATION TRAINING USING RECYCLED PLASTIC BOTTLES



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
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ANTI-TOBACCO WEBINAR

Tobacco can also be deadly for non-smokers. Second-hand smoke exposure has also been implicated in adverse health outcomes, causing 1.2 million deaths annually. Nearly half of all children breathe air polluted by tobacco smoke and 65000 children die each year due to illnesses related to second-hand smoke. Smoking while pregnant can lead to several life-long health- conditions for babies." - He said. College principal Dr. Muhammadali inaugurated the webinar.




COMMIT TO QUIT- NO-Tobacco Observation


Y FOR YOGA


FOOD DISTRIBUTION

CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAMME



ANTI-DRUG AWARENESS PROGRAMME



GENERAL AWARENESS WEBINAR ON CORONA VIRUS/COVID-19 TREATEMENTS AND CHALLENGES



ABHAYAM- HOUSE CONSTRUCTION

In the "Abhayam Home for Homeless" housing project as the NSS Flagship program announced in connection with Calicut University Golden Jubilee celebrations, our NSS units - 97&172 are jointly building a house of 825 Sq ft. for a economically backward family of a physically and mentally unhealthy person. Though we proposed this programme during the difficult times of covid 19 and its resultant lockdown, volunteers welcomed this project wholeheartedly with full of eagerness and pleasure.

Volunteers are doing all possible construction activities, helping professional workers, raised necessary funds, and organised a variety of fund collection drives, such as coupen collection, Bucket collections, Class collection, etc. The NSS team started its work by forming a housing construction committee consisting of natives and finding the necessary materials for the construction of the house from the well-wishers of the college through sponsorships.

When volunteers saw the poor family, consisting of a mother, three sons- all physically weak, and their families living in a hut like home, they realized how blessed they were. This heartbreaking experience helped them to move forward with the project. We have a home to live in, but there are too many people around us who don't have a home, extremely poor people who have no shelter of their own, to live safely in the hot sun, severe cold, and heavy rains! Even animals or birds around us need a nest to stay. Such heart-pounding experiences drove them forward. They have successfully overcome each crisis.

FINDING THE BENEFICIARY FOR "ABHAYAM"

In the NSS ABHAYAM Project, Calicut University has called upon us to provide houses for people who own at least 3 cents of land. We consulted with the Ward Member to find the apt beneficiary for the program. It was his suggestion and later when the Principal, Management Committee members and Programme officers visited the house of the proposed beneficiary, we found that he is the apt person in the surrounding area.






DRY DAY OBSERVATION


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GANDHI JAYANTHI CELEBRATIONS- SWACCH BHARATH ABHIYAN

Sparsham is a unique programme of Majlis Arts and science college NSS units, where we join our hands with the Department of Health, Secondary palliative and geriatric care Department. CHC Puzhakkattiri

As we know, Palliative patients are the ones who are supposed to suffer throughout their life. Palliative care is a crucial part of integrated, people-centred health services. Relieving serious health-related suffering, be it physical, psychological, social, or spiritual, is a global ethical responsibility. Thus, whether the cause of suffering is cardiovascular disease, cancer, major organ failure, drugresistant tuberculosis, severe burns, end-stage chronic illness, acute trauma, extreme birth prematurity or extreme frailty of old age, palliative care may be needed and has to be available at all levels of care.

It is estimated that globally only 14% of patients who need palliative care receive it; to achieve Sustainable Development Goal 3, working towards universal health coverage, we have to strengthen palliative care services. WHO works with countries to include palliative care as a key part of their health systems. To improve equitable access to palliative care services, emphasis is given to a Primary Health Care approach. Assessment tools have been developed to measure progress made. Strong partnerships are in place to develop and implement technical guidance, to strengthen capacity and to disseminate information.

Palliative system is strong enough in our District. But as the Secondary palliative and geriatric care Department is a government initiative, they are having many difficulties finding additional support. Here is the role of the Sparsham Programme of Our NSS units. The major aim of the programme is to make Palliative patients economically Self-sufficient thus to make them proud of themselves.




SNEHAPUTHAPP- BLANKET DONATION
