ANNUAL REPORT 2020-21

I have immense pleasure to present before you the annual report of academic year 2020-21 of Majlis Arts and Science College, Puramannur.

The academic year started on 1st June, 2020. There were 16 UG Programmes and PG Programmes. There were 2142 UG and 202 PG students, out of which 1282 Male students and 1062 female students. Total number of teaching staff were 105 and Non-teaching staff were 27.

Because of the Covid-19 pandemic the regular classes were conducted online. Teachers extensively used Learning Management System like Google Class Room, Edmodo and Moodle. Google Meet, Zoom and also webEx were also used for student-teacher interaction. The e-Content Development Centre of Majlis Arts and Science College produced 225 videos which was a record e-Content production in the history in Kerala by any college. College also conducted offline classes and practicals obeying covid protocol when the lock down was lifted. The seven day NSS camps, Onam Celebration, X-mas Celebrations were also organised online. Independence day and Republic day were celebrated with great joy and fervour.

College conducted Faculty Development Programme (FDP) in collaboration with CALEM, Aligarh Muslim University under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teacher and Teaching, under Ministry of Education Government of India.

College has started 3800 free massive online open course of coursera in the academic year 2020-21 for its students alumni and public.

Contruccion of new canteen, rennovation of library and computer science laboratories also initiated by the college management committee.

College NSS Unit has initiated construction of Home for Homeless with the support of student community in the adopted village.

College NSS Units organised large number extension activities during the pandemic period. Donating of Masks, Pulse Oximeters, PPE Kits to needy people were some of the activities by NSS Units. Covid awareness programme by making short videos and 200 posters promulgated in social medias by the Media and Communication Department.

Covid vaccination registration camps by Dept. of Computer Science, Covid awareness activities of Microbiology Department in collaboration with Moulana Hospital, Perinthalmanna. Sanitizer preparation by Dept. of chemistry, LED Manufacture workshop by Dept. of Physics, Survey on various impacts of Covid-19 by Sociology Department and Commerce Departments were praise worthy cooperations.

Eventhough there was tremendous pressure on all the stake holders by Covid-19, the academic year 2020-21 was another year of success for Majlis fraternity. The college has completed stage one activity for NAAC Accreditation works.

I would like to express profound gratitude to all the staff members, teaching and non-teaching, the Head of various departments in particular college office superintendent and administrative staff and the college management committee for their consistent efforts in pursuit of excellence to the institution.
